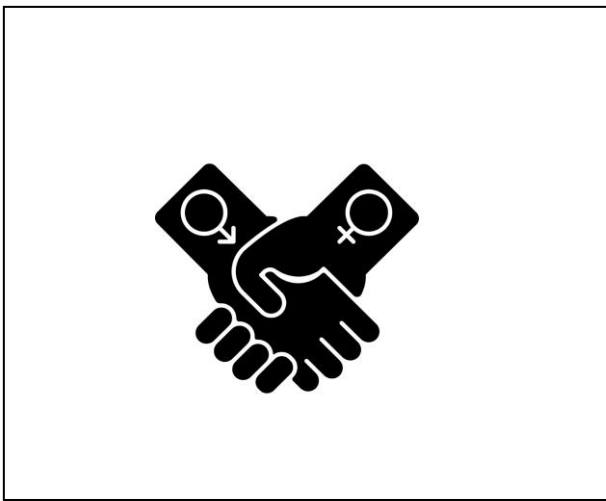


Gender equality
