



## THE FINNS ARE NUMBER ONE AGAIN 1/2

The Czech Republic ranks as the 18th happiest nation in the world, according to the annual World Happiness Reportpublished by the nonprofit organization SDSN, which is affiliated with the United Nations. The Finns once again claimed the top spot in the rankings, marking their sixth consecutive year at number one. In general, the Nordic countries consistently perform best in these evaluations.

The ranking is based on a variety of factors, including life expectancy, gross domestic product, levels of corruption in public institutions, social support, and the degree of freedom in making important life decisions. Finland excels in all these aspects, followed closely by Denmark, then Iceland, Israel, the Netherlands, Sweden, Norway, Switzerland, Luxembourg, with New Zealand rounding out the top ten.

According to one of the study's authors, John Helliwell, the COVID-19 pandemic did not significantly affect the rankings. "Despite these challenging times, positive emotions remained more prevalent than negative ones, and feelings of social support triumphed over loneliness," Helliwell told CNN.



Afghanistan is Last

In the second tier of the happiest nations are Austria, Australia, Canada, Ireland, the USA, Germany, Belgium, the Czech Republic, the United Kingdom, and Lithuania, which has made a significant jump from its previous position of 52nd over the past six years. "This is essentially the same story that has played out in the rest of Central and Eastern Europe," Helliwell said, adding that former Soviet Union states have undergone significant development since the 1990s and are now more secure in their new identities.

On the opposite end of the ranking, Afghanistan holds the position as the least happy country. Just above it are Lebanon, Sierra Leone, Zimbabwe, the Democratic Republic of Congo, Botswana, Malawi, Comoros, Tanzania, Zambia, and Madagascar.
